# Counter UAS Tactical Development Course CTDC

The Counter UAS Tactical Development Course is a 7-day course.

- 2-days at home station training
- 3-days hard skills tactical training
  - Drivers Training
  - Firearms Training
- 2-days full mission profile operations with red team UAS interjected into missions

Units will conduct three full mission profile lanes that are designed to develop their C-UAS SOPs while still being expected to complete their mission.

CTDC culminates in a live-fire exercise where units will be expected to defeat red team UAS

## Counter UAS Basic Reconnaissance Training

C-UAS Basic Reconnaissance training program is a MTT or can be held at one of our partner tactical training facility locations.

We work with teams on how to augment C-UAS into their basic and or urban reconnaissance operations in high threat UAS and UAV environments.

Teams are trained on how to employ man-packable and wearable C-UAS equipment, employee/practice signature reduction techniques and develop their C-UAS and C-UAV SOPS to increase mission success and survivability in the enemy UAS and UAV domain

The C-UAS GCS Terminal Guidance Course can be added to this course and will train units on how to find, fix and locate UAS and UAV controller teams.





## EW/SIGINT Reconnaissance Training

EW/SIGINT Basic Reconnaissance training program is a MTT or can be held at one of our partner tactical training facility locations.

We instruct teams on how to augment EW/SIGINT into their basic and or urban reconnaissance force protection posture.

This training can also be layered with C-UAS, S-UAS, Signature Reduction and any hard skills training required.





## Counter UAS Amphibious Reconnaissance Training

The C-UAS Amphibious Reconnaissance training program is a MTT course that trains amphibious reconnaissance teams on how to conduct amphibious reconnaissance operations in an enemy UAS and UAV domain.

The essential elements taught in the C-UAS Basic Reconnaissance program are the foundation of this course while considering other operational variables that must always be considered in maritime operations.

The C-UAS GCS Terminal Guidance Course can be added to this course and will train units on how to find, fix and locate sUAS, UAV and UMS controller teams





## EW/SIGINT Amphibious Reconnaissance Training

The EW/SIGINT Amphibious Reconnaissance training program is a MTT course that trains amphibious reconnaissance teams on how to support amphibious reconnaissance operations while conducting EW/SIGINT force protection overwatch or targeting operation.

This course can be layered with C-UAS, S-UAS, Signature Reduction and any hard skills training required.





## Terminal Guidance Course

The Terminal Guidance Course is designed to train personnel on how to employ C-UAS and other EW/SIGINT equipment along with unclassified and classified data sources to not only defend against the nefarious actors but to also find, fix, locate and remove them from the battlefield.

This course is tailorable to fit the specific needs of units with the authorities to conduct offensive targeting operations.

The methodologies taught in this course can be taught at both classified and unclassified levels.





## Group 3 & 4 UAV Defense Course

## Lead Instructor BIO

Craig Kubala is the Director of Counter UAS Training & Operations for Imperative Systems, LLC. He was a plank owner on Team ICARUS, which was a five-man- DTRA/JIDO, NSA and NRO team stood up in 2016 that used national level assets to geo-locate, track and conduct time sensitive terminal guidance kinetic strikes on over 400 ISIS Group 1 and 2 UAS pilot teams in Iraq, Syria and Afghanistan.

2018/2019 Craig Kubala switched over to a team focused on the Yemen Houthi Group 3 UAV threat. This 8-man Joint Task Force team was responsible for geo-locating, tracking and conducting time sensitive kinetic strikes on an undisclosed number of Houthi UAV pilot and launch teams.

2019/2021 Craig Kubala was on a team that installed defensive counter UAS systems CONUS and OCONUS at some of our nations most sensitive DoD installations and other undisclosed national sensitive sites.

2001/2022 Craig Kubala stood up the first Counter UAS Tactical Development Course. This is a one-of-a-kind full mission profile counter UAS course designed to train tactical maneuver element how to employ mobile counter UAS systems. This course is a SOP development course that is constantly implementing the newest TTPs & SOPs from both friendly and enemy COAs.
